Merry Christmas!

Any child placed in your home after October 31st may be reimbursed for the cost of one Christmas gift . Foster parents should request approval from the

Case Worker or CSD Worker, and receipts need to be forwarded to your Support Worker for approval.



December is the time for...year end paperwork!

Your Foster Care Support Worker will be bringing out year end paperwork during a November or December home visit. These are processed as follows:

- Two copies of the new contract will be brought out. Both foster parents must sign and date both copies of the contract. Your FCSW must also sign (witness) both copies. Foster parents retain one copy; one copy is returned to the office for data entry and is then placed on the foster parent file.
- One copy of the sub-delegation will be brought out. A second copy will be placed on the foster parent file.
- A blank copy of the Fire Drill Log will be brought out to record fire drills for 2020. Foster parents should turn in their completed 2019 Fire Drill Log at this time (or prior to December 31st if they have not completed all required fire drills for 2019 at the time of the home visit). The completed 2019 log is returned to the office for data entry and is then placed on the foster parent file. Thanks to all those who have already turned in their 2019 log!
- If there are children 12 or over in the foster home, your FCSW will review the Child/Youth Orientation Handbook with them. The child will then sign & date a form indicating they have reviewed the handbook. This form will be returned to the office for data entry and then placed on the child's file.
- This year you will be asked to fill out a new Emergency Contact Form. This will be returned to the office and placed on the foster parent file.
