All food will be provided, but you're welcome to bring a family favourite or dessert if you wish.


Also bring: lawn chairs, sunscreen, mosquito repellent & hats.

- ⇒ All receipts should be submitted as jpegs or PDF scans whenever possible. They must be legible. Photographing them against a white background with a good light source should ensure they're bright enough to reproduce once received in the office. Receipts must show date of purchase and method of payment.
- ⇒ If a child has had a medical appointment, a Month End Report must still be completed for that month as well.
- Please ensure that dates for medical appointments are accurate.
