Km Guidelines - HUB Submissions Helpful Reminders For New and Not So New Families!

- If siblings are being driven at the same time to the same destination, do only one submission in the older child's name and claim for the full amount of km. If siblings have separate drives, do two separate submissions.
- Don't put drives for multiple children with different workers in one submission. If they are sharing a drive, divide the km and do two submissions.
- Put only one month's worth of drives on a single submission and submit them each month. Please wait until all drives have been completed for the month before submitting.
- If your drive involves a round trip indicate this in the "purpose for trip" field.
- For trips that would involve a greater than expected amount of km (for example detour taken for road construction), indicate the reason why in the "purpose for trip" field.
- Submit parking receipts along with km. Receipts can be uploaded.
- Don't submit a claim for a drive before it occurs, even if the drive has been scheduled in advance (for example for an on-going appointment) as plans can change. If the office receives such a claim, it will be held until after the date of the drive. Foster parents may be contacted to verify the drive has taken place.
- Remember that approvals for all km are submitted to the Case Worker or CSD Worker. Foster parents can't be reimbursed until a signed authorization has been received.

Contract Year End is March 31st

All receipts for children in your care should be handed in as soon as possible **before** the end of March.

PLEASE NOTE: Receipts for Recreation or Vacation/Camp related items that are to be taken from 2024/25 Funds must be dated on or before March 31, 2025 and will NOT be paid to foster parents if they are handed in after April 30th as the region allows only one extra month to bill these costs back. Thanks for your cooperation during this busy time of year.
